Guillermo Focacci Aste (1922–2000) defined several of the archaeological phases in northern Chilean archaeology, and trained a large number of students in the field. While there have been short obituary notices in various journals, Luis Álvarez Miranda, editor of *Revista Diálogo Andino*, the archaeological series of the Universidad de Tarapacá in Chile, has provided a more detailed analysis of his contributions.
